SHERIFF - Last day to **FILE** with POST
ROAD SUPERINTENDENT - Last day to **FILE** with THOCB

QUALIFYING DEADLINE: **FEBRUARY 20, 2014 - 12:00 NOON** – Last day to qualify
ALL CANDIDATES (Take note of noon deadline!!)

WITHDRAWAL DEADLINE: FEBRUARY 27, 2014 – **12:00 NOON** – Last day qualified candidates may withdraw their name from the ballot

***WRITE-IN'S BOARD FILING DEADLINE:** MARCH 3, 2014 – **12:00 NOON** – Last day a *write-in* Sheriff or Road Superintendent candidate may file with the appropriate certifying board for candidate's name to be counted on the ballot

WRITE-IN DEADLINE: MARCH 17, 2014 – **12:00 NOON** – Last day a write-in certificate shall be issued for candidate's name to be counted on the ballot

REGISTRATION DEADLINE: MONDAY, APRIL 7, 2014 – All registrations postmarked by this date will be processed for the May 6, 2014 election.

EARLY VOTING PERIOD: APRIL 16, 2014 THROUGH MAY 1, 2014
